

Three Borders Landmark - Brazil







Destination: Iguazú

Description

The wide viewpoint of the Three Borders allows the contemplation of the boundaries between the three countries. The visitor is able to perceive the geological formation, which occurred millions of years ago, of the territories that today belong to Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay.

The place has a safe and accessible infrastructure so that visitors can contemplate the day, the sunset and the nightfall. The viewpoint is the stage of the daily spectacle of lights and water jets that surround the Obelisk.

The Visitors Center is where it all begins. The space offers restrooms, souvenir shop and information on the tourist attraction. With a remarkable architecture inspired by the buildings of the Jesuit Missions, the Visitor Center has 700 square meters of facilities.
